All listed tracts have an estimated population greater than 0. Also, some area's self-response rates may reflect the suspension of the Census Bureau's Update Leave operation.

Changes in U.S. Census Bureau geography and methodology prevent an exact comparison between 2020 and 2010 response rates. With that in mind:

"Red" tracts have a cumulative SRR less than 80 percent of the tract's calculated final 2010 self-response rate.

"Yellow" tracts have a cumulative SRR 80%-100% of the tract's calculated final 2010 self-response rate.

"Green" tracts have a cumulative SRR >= 100% of the tract's calculated final 2010 self-response rate.
